Hardware Requirements

To participate campers/students will need:

- A computer – Mac or PC (please check individual camp requirements,)
- A web cam and microphone
- A high-speed Internet Connection

Please note that Chromebooks, I pads and Tablets are unable to install and run most of the software we use in the programs.

Zoom Meeting Software

All virtual programs are held in Zoom Meeting Rooms. Each camper/student will receive an Access Link prior to the start of the camp or program. This Link will be sent out one or two days before the start of the program.

Check it out ahead of time. Zoom let's you adjust the audio and webcam settings to achieve the best experience!
